Stress Tip - Not by Your Power

If concerns and uncertainty have taken away your strength, your hope and love for life; you have forgotten that God is the source of your strength, hope, and love.

The Bible teaches us about dealing with stress:

"Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, this is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts."

(Zechariah 4:6 KJV)
